

Audience Etiquette

We want you to have the best possible experience during your visit so please make sure to refresh your Audience Etiquette before joining us at the theatre:

FOOD AND DRINKS

Please enjoy your food and drinks before entering the theatre.

SCHOOL BAGS

Make sure you leave school bags on the bus or at home as they aren't permitted in the theatre. Small handbags are okay.

NB for Day With State performances: school bags can be left in the foyer.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Switch off all electronic devices so that no interruption can disrupt our performers or your show.

NOTE TAKING

A magical moment is easily missed in live performance; we encourage note taking during interval and after the performance but not during the show. The humans on stage can be easily distracted!

REACTIONS

Laughter, tears, gasps and sighs are all appropriate reactions when genuinely expressed but please save talking for interval and after the show.

LENGTH OF PERFORMANCE

The length of a performance in the study guide is an estimation made during rehearsals. For updated details check out our website. If leaving the theatre during a performance, please be as quiet as possible; re-entry will be permitted only via Front of House staff supervision.
