Objectives:

- To celebrate student's creative work
- To give students and teachers an opportunity to see what others create when given similar parameters
- To engage and encourage students to continue with their Drama studies
- For students and teachers to receive feedback from industry professionals
- To engage students in Tertiary Arts spaces, encouraging them into Performing Arts tertiary study and careers

Key Stimulus: Truth

Using the prompt of Truth, in your devising, in your story telling, in your presentation, in your making, create work that speaks truth to yourselves and the audience.

Key Innovator: Physical Theatre

- You can choose from a selection of Physical Theatre styles, Frantic Assembly, Viewpoints, Laban or even clowning. This will give work focus, but also enable collective works to have a thematic throughline/key idea

Work is designed to fit within the Stage 1 AT1 (Performance assessment) or AT3 Creative Synthesis.

Parameters for students/teachers.

- The performance should have no more than four lighting states and must be pre programmed with CueLab. Sound design should also be pre set.
- A stage manager will be provided
- Each school is given a maximum of 15 minutes to perform, with a 45 minute bump in/tech. This day will be provided prior to the performance on the 29 October. It is a requirement for the group to attend the rehearsal/bump in.
- State Theatre Company artists to connect with classes to provide workshop

Competition Details:

- Judging panel will comprise a representative from State Theatre Company, Drama South Australia and Flinders University.
- Awards/Prizes will focus on giving students unique theatre experiences; Including;
- Subscription to the 2027 State Theatre Company season
- Invitation to view a State Theatre Company South Australia Dress Rehearsal
